The facility is equipped with indoor and outdoor space for safe, well supervised and age appropriate programming with emphasis on homework assistance, tutoring, socio-emotional curriculum, nutrition, recreation, and STEAM centered activities. Families are strengthened through Parent Support Activities, helping them to reach and maintain self-sufficiency.
