WE BELIEVE

Catholic Charities CYO Transportation has been providing school bus services to public, private, and parochial schools as well as youth-serving organizations for over 40 years. Approximately 1,250 children, including low-income children and children with special needs, are transported to and from school on CYO Transportation buses each day. An additional 90,000 children rely on our buses for charter and activity trips, field and athletic trips, and camp transportation annually.

SERVICES

- Provide safe transportation to daily route riders on over 70 routes
- Provide safe transportation to clients for field trips, athletic trips, camp trips and retreats
- Provide support to agency programs
- Maintain a fleet of over 30 buses and 3 various sized trucks

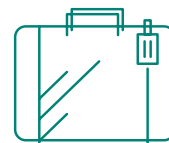
