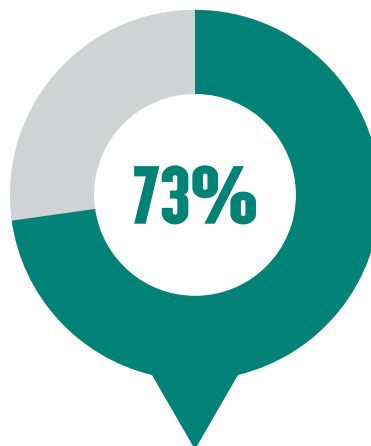

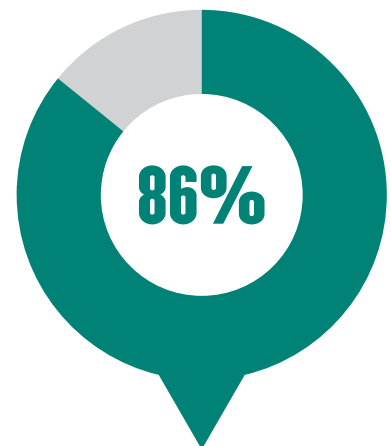
These results are based on the self-sufficiency matrix assessment tool completed for the head of household.

Catholic Charities Star Community Home assists families citywide who, but for this assistance, would become homeless. We help these families to obtain and/or maintain stable housing through temporary financial assistance and housing stabilization services.

Star Community Home began in January 2012 and provides housing and services to homeless single mothers with children at the former convent at Star of the Sea Parish in San Francisco.

SERVICES

- Emergency shelter and meals in a safe environment
- Links to rental subsidies and supportive services
- Intensive case management
- Information, resources and referral to community support resources
- Budget counseling and job search support
- Parenting and interpersonal skills workshops
